### **Digital Meetings**

The High Court hearing took place today (Wednesday 21 April). As soon as we have any more details, we shall put colleagues know.

Lawyers in Local Govt. have placed the following on their website

"Proceedings for a court declaration that virtual meetings can proceed past 6th May 2021 was heard today in the High Court before the President of the Queen's Bench Division, Dame Victoria Sharp and the Hon Mr Martin Chamberlain QC.

LLG, ADSO and Hertfordshire County Council instructed Counsel, Peter Oldham QC of 11KBW to make submissions and we thank The Local Government Association and the National Association of Local Councils for their participation as interested parties.

We now await the judgement of the court which, given the urgency of the situation, is expected earlier than might otherwise be the case."

No indications have been given of the possible decision as yet.

## **Changes to Permitted Development Rights - Commercial to Residential**

In Autumn 2020 MHCLG consulted on changes to permitted developments to extend the rights to convert commercial property to residential use.

The legislation has now been made with some significant changes from last year's proposals. Some protection is given the ground floor use but only in conservation areas.

The national NALC have produced a briefing which ONLY applies to local councils who are VAT Registered. It does NOT apply to Local Councils who only claim VAT under s33 of the VAT Act 1994 (i.e. by completing a VAT126 Form)..
