Northumberland Development Control Briefings

Dear Chairman and Clerks,

With apologies for the short notice, especially for the meetings next week, the County Council has arranged briefings for Town & Parish Councillors alongside the July meetings of the County Council's Local Area Councils.

The July briefings will cover

- The draft Core Strategy (particularly in the light of the debate scheduled for this afternoon's meeting of the County Council) and
- Material /Non-Material Planning Considerations

There will be a further round of briefings in the autumn covering

- Conditions and S106 Planning Obligations/Agreements
- Enforcement
- Heritage

There will also be a Saturday morning session, probably in November at County Hall, covering all five points.

July Briefing for the North & Tynedale Areas are in the course of arrangement. Parish and Town Councillors may attend any session even if their Council is not in the particular area.

The first 3 have been arranged prior to meetings of the LACs as follows:

July

Castle Morpeth LAC, 10 July, Council Chamber Morpeth. LAC Meeting at 5pm **Training at 4pm.**

Ashington/Blyth LAC, 12 July at Briardale Centre, Blyth. LAC Meeting at 5pm **Therefore training will be at 4pm**

Bedlington/Cramlington/Seaton Valley LAC, 19 July Concordia. LAC Meeting 5pm **Training at 4pm**

There will be no training prior to the North or Tynedale LACS, given their earlier start times. Mark will arrange separate training sessions within those areas in July, dates to be agreed.

It is envisaged that all training will be completed at those sessions although a 'mop up' session will be held if necessary on a Saturday morning in November.

Any Town and Parish Councillor can attend any of the sessions and will be offered the opportunity to stay and observe the LAC Planning meeting straight afterwards, so they can see how the applications are debated and determined by Committee.
